Recreation...

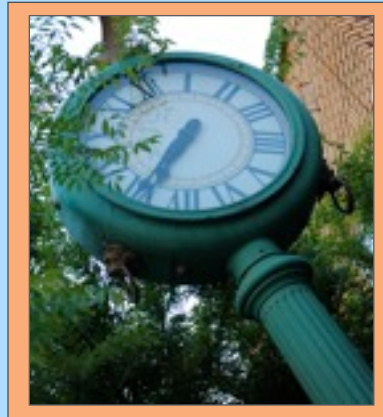
